Sporty Waves: "The Seattle look is athletic and outdoorsy, but women still want great hair," says Natalie Angelillo, co-owner of Swink Style Bar.

Translation: loose, unstructured

waves that are unfinished at the ends. Prep your roots with a touch of dry shampoo for texture, then use a 1½-inch flatiron to create tousled waves. Starting at your ear, gently clamp a small, 1½-inch section of hair in the iron, rotate your hand 180 degrees, then gently slide the iron down the hair while holding the tool vertically, like using scissors blades to curl ribbon (the slower you move the iron, the tighter the curl). Stop 2 inches from the bottom for an unfinished effect. Alternate the direction of the curl throughout. Finish with a texturizing hairspray and brush through.
